

INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTER AUTHORS AT THE 9TH INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF ANAESTHESIOLOGISTS and INTENSIVISTS IN SLOVENIA

LJUBLJANA, SEPTEMBER 25–27, 2026

On behalf of the organizing and scientific committee of the Congress, we invite you to submit your contributions within the “Posters” free topics section.

Conditions for poster submission:

- The work must be original and approved by the author or co-authors (maximum 5) for publication in the Congress Proceedings 2026.
- The title and content with the listed author(s) must not have been previously published.
- It must include a statement of conflict of interest.
- If artificial intelligence was used, this must be stated in the abstract.
- Indicate the name and surname of the author who will give the oral presentation at the Congress; this person must be registered and have paid the registration fee.
- Include your email address in the submission.

Submission deadline:

Tuesday, May 21, 2026, by 12:00 noon

Structure of the written contribution:

Case report:

- Introduction: define the clinical problem or question, explain the educational relevance
- Main part: description of the clinical case, positive and negative findings, investigations/treatment/outcome
- Discussion: summarize key points demonstrating the relevance/interest of the case
- References: up to 5, cited using the Vancouver style
- Learning points

Other (scientific or professional paper):

- Introduction and aim
- Methodology
- Results
- Discussion and conclusion
- References: up to 5, cited using the Vancouver style
- Acknowledgements

Writing guidelines:

- The topic should be related to anesthesiology, perioperative intensive care, resuscitation, acute and chronic pain, safety and quality in anesthesia, ethics, or sustainability.
- The contribution should be written in Slovenian or English as a Word document, font Times New Roman, size 12.
- The abstract should be up to 450 words and structured as described above.
- It may include images, graphs, and/or illustrations (maximum 3 total).
- Submissions will not be proofread; the author is responsible for spelling and professional content.

The poster committee will review all submissions and inform you via email about further procedures.

POSTER PREPARATION

If your submission is accepted for presentation at the Congress, you will be notified by Tuesday, June 9, 2026.

The author is responsible for preparing the poster and bringing it to the Congress on Friday, September 25, 2025, by 10:00 AM. Posters will be displayed in the area in front of the main lecture hall.

The poster must include: title (identical to the written submission), author(s), content, images, and conclusion.

Poster size:

- Paper format: **B1 vertical (1000 mm x 700 mm, height x width)**
- Other sizes or formats are not allowed due to space limitations
- The layout should allow reading from top to bottom

The author will be informed later about the date and time of their **5-minute presentation** in front of the poster.

The poster committee will select the **4 best posters**. Authors will be notified in advance and invited to present their topic in the main Congress programme on Sunday, September 27, 2026, at 8:15 AM.
